As part of our celebrations, it has been decided to set up a fund to give thanks to God for the past 100 years of the life of the Diocese.

The Southwark Diocesan Centenary Fund has been set up by Bishop Tom to support work with children and young people throughout the Diocese.

**Fundraising by the trustees will target a number of sources including local businesses, city institutions, grant giving organisations as well as parishes throughout the Diocese. Groups will be able to apply for grants from late 2005 and all applications for grants will be assessed by the Grants Committee, which is chaired by Bishop Nick.**

**Initial publicity will be through a series of road shows, one in each archdeaconry. These road shows aim to give parishes the opportunity to hear about current work with young people and to share their visions for the future. It is hoped that they will develop enthusiasm for both the fund and for its potential benefits for our young people. Details of the road shows are outlined below. The Clergy, PCC secretaries, Area Deans and Lay Chairs in each archdeaconry will be formally invited but anyone interested in youth and children’s work is very welcome to attend on any evening.**
