AIMS OF THE SESSION

- To provide information about the legal responsibilities governors have as employers of staff in church schools in relation to grievance and discipline, dismissals and appeals;
- To look at the policies and procedures which need to be in place to enable governors to deal with such matters in a fair, consistent and objective way;
- To explore the role of governors in handling issues and in particular their participation in hearings; and
- To equip participants with the skills and knowledge to assist them to carry out their duties effectively

The session will be a mixture of tutor input and group discussion and will provide an opportunity to network with governors from other schools. Participants will receive an information pack and should come prepared to participate; there will be plenty of opportunity to ask questions.
