The church of All Saints West Dulwich is coming to the end of a five year re-building and re-development project following a fire in June 2000. We are now entering an exciting phase of this project as we look ahead to moving back into our church building in early 2006. We are keen to maximise the opportunities for mission and outreach which our new building will offer both within our congregation and with the wider local community.

We are looking to appoint an Operations Manager to work with us as we plan and implement the initial phase of the building re-opening and beyond.
